Family & Divorce Mediation



Family & Divorce Mediation is a process to help families and couples effectively manage conflicts and resolve disputes which may arise during divorce proceedings.

The goal of Mediation is to help couples and/or families in resolving differences and to help minimize legal costs including court fees. In this process, couples maintain control over matters including financial and custody/visitation issues without having to wait for a lengthy court process that often increases anxiety, stress and other emotional issues. Mediation is a cost-effective method to settle divorce matters.

How does the Mediation Process help?

- The Mediator is a neutral professional who is specifically trained to assist those in conflict
- The process is designed to help people clearly define issues in conflict and reach agreements best suited to their needs and interest
- Mediation helps parties find their own solutions and shared interests
- This process empowers participants to make their own decisions

How long does Mediation take?

Each session is two hours. The number of sessions necessary depends upon each party's situation and their ability to reach amicable agreements. Participants generally require 6 to 8 sessions.

How much does Mediation cost?

Mediation is a cost effective alternative as it helps to save money on attorney fees and court costs. Please call for more information.
