



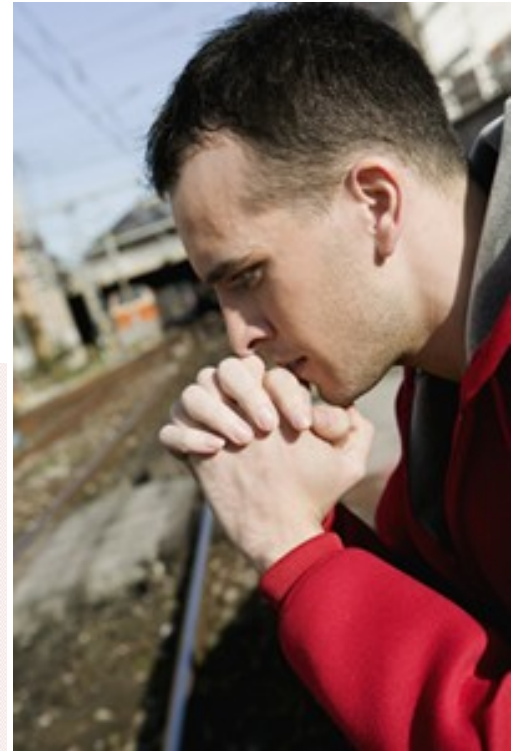

Do you know someone who may be suffering from **DEPRESSION** and could benefit from a clinical research trial?

We're currently enrolling participants in several depression studies. Common symptoms of depression include:

- difficulty concentrating and making decisions
- fatigue and decreased energy
- feelings of guilt, worthlessness, and/or helplessness
- feelings of hopelessness and/or pessimism
- insomnia or excessive sleeping
- irritability, restlessness
- loss of interest in activities or hobbies once pleasurable
- overeating or appetite loss
- persistent aches/pains; headaches; digestive problems
- persistent sad, anxious, or "empty" feelings
- thoughts of suicide, suicide attempts



If any of these symptoms sound familiar, **you may be eligible** to participate in one of our clinical research studies. The goal of clinical research is to help manage or alleviate symptoms associated with psychiatric illness.

If you decide to participate you may receive medical and psychiatric evaluations provided at **no cost** to you. Compensation for time and travel may also be available.
